1. Select racket:

 <p>A. JONYER-H</p>	<p>Butterfly's opinion: The most popular blade in this class during recent years. Many players love the comparable Hinoki feel, found in the JONYER-H and several of the carbon blades. Over time, the comfortable Redwood handle shapes to your grip. The FL version has a more compact head than the AN.</p> <p>Speed: 7.5 Control: 7.7 Grip: AN, FL</p> <p>I really like this blade – I've used it for the past 2 years.  <p>B. PRIMORAC</p>	<p>Butterfly's opinion: Butterfly's best-selling shakehand blade. Its African wood allows the ball to stay on the racket longer providing good feel and control. A good all-round offensive blade.  <p>C. SCHLAGER</p>	<p>Butterfly's opinion: Koto outer plies and German Spruce secondary plies. A good topspin blade for all types of loop shots.  <p>A. EKRIPS</p>	<p>Butterfly's opinion: Designed for close-to-the-table power play, EKRIPS' soft rubber surface makes it easier to counterdrive your opponent's shots early off the bounce. EKRIPS' highly elastic sponge produces very fast, low trajectory shots that lay down the smack.</p> <p>Spin: 8.4 Speed: 10.2</p> <p>This rubber is great for fast attacks.  <p>B. SRIVER-EL</p>	<p>Butterfly's opinion: Butterfly proudly introduces the newest member of the SRIVER family, SRIVER-EL (ELastic). The latest genre combines SRIVER's top sheet with a medium-soft elastic sponge that until recently had been specially selected only for our leading world ranked players. If your requirement is in between hard sponge and soft sponge, then we recommend the new SRIVER-EL.</p> <p>Spin: 8.2 Speed: 9.8</p> <p>This rubber is designed for all around offence. Designed for players wanting to play an all-round game with the maximum amount of spin. TACKIFIRE also has the speed the modern topspin player needs to finish the point with strong looping strokes.</p> <p>Spin: 9.3 Speed: 9.0</p> <p>This is the spinniest of the rubbers here – ideal for a looping style. **D: Bryce**

As both rubber and sponge are flexible and highly resilient, they catch and absorb the oncoming ball and catapult it with your own added speed and spin. Top 20 world ranked Kalin Kreanga and Werner Schlager play with BRYCE.

**E: Impartial****\$24.75**

One of the best "consummate" power hitting pips-out rubbers. Impartial's extra rebound speed allows penetrating attack strokes from both close and middle distances from the table. Used by 1996 Olympic Bronze Medalist, Park Hae Jung.

Master Chack adds that extra speed and spin your game needs. Glue effect lasts up to six hours. Master Chack is wetter and thinner than Fair Chack with a longer drying time. This requires less glue when applying which will make your glue last longer and reduce the build-up on the sponge surface. Of all the glues that Butterfly carries, Master Chack is the fastest by far. Can comes with built-in brush on lid for easy application.
